



Alameda County Vaccine Eligibility Criteria

Last Updated: 03/17/2021

This document provides an overview of current COVID-19 vaccine eligibility, vaccinating organizations/entities, and ways to sign-up to be vaccinated. Please note that eligibility criteria will continue to be updated based on capacity and vaccine availability; the following two tables will continue to be updated as more information becomes available.

As of March 15, people age 16-64 who are deemed to be at the very highest risk due to complex health conditions are eligible for vaccination. **Verification documentation of the diagnosis or type of disability is not required.** Please read the California Department of Public Health Vaccine Eligibility Guidelines for more details:

Severe health conditions include:

- Cancer, current with weakened immune system
- Chronic kidney disease, stage 4 or above
- Chronic pulmonary disease, oxygen dependent
- Down syndrome
- Solid organ transplant, leading to a weakened immune system
- Pregnancy
- Sickle cell disease
- Heart conditions, such as heart failure, coronary artery disease, or cardiomyopathies (but not hypertension)
- Severe obesity (Body Mass Index \geq 40 kg/m²)
- Type 2 diabetes mellitus with hemoglobin A1c level greater than 7.5

Individuals with developmental or other severe disabilities or illness, including a range of physical and behavioral disabilities, are also eligible for vaccine.
